## How stakeholder collaboration and the MECS jigsaw theory of change helped identify projects

#### The MECS Jigsaw country level theory of change


- Jigsaw of pieces, where all pieces need to be in place to enable eCooking scale up.
- The jigsaw framework consists of 3 core areas. Each consisting of various elements

#### Collaboration

- Ongoing stakeholder engagement in Nepal since the programme's inception in 2018
- 2022: MECS met with eCooking stakeholders in Nepal to discuss key questions for each jigsaw element.

#### Outcomes

- Possible to identify gaps in the Nepal jigsaw.
- 18 projects developed to help address gaps and support eCooking scale up in Nepal.



#### **Key Questions**

- 1. What work is currently taking place in Nepal for each element?
  - a. Which stakeholders are involved?
  - b. Stakeholders who could (should) be involved?
- 2. What is missing from each element?
  - a. Who could (is best placed to) be involved in working on these missing components?
- 3. What opportunities are there for MECS to act?





# Why we want to encourage information sharing and coordination in the eCooking sector

- Build on each others learnings
- Identify areas of collaboration/avoid duplication
- Share best practice
- Improve outreach to all parts of Nepal
- Enable a more rapid and effective transition to genuinely clean cooking in Nepal and the achievement of national eCooking targets
